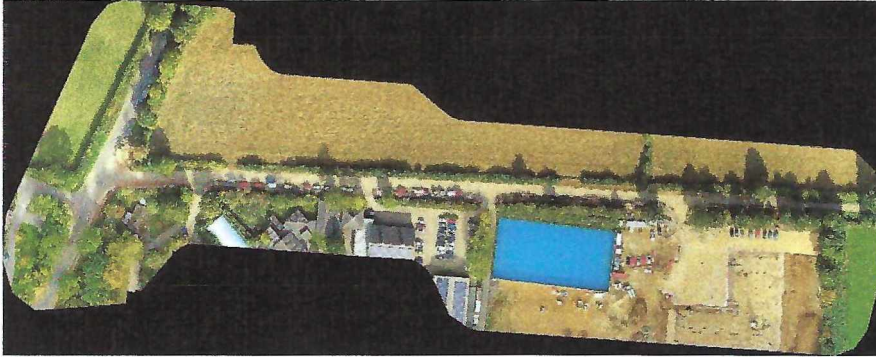


Community Newsletter October 2022

Bloxham Grove Academy



Dear Neighbours,

Our works along Bloxham Grove Road and Banbury Road are progressing well and the works on site have now started in earnest.

We have completed the majority of the road works along Bloxham Grove Road, the street lights are due w/c 24.10.22, once these have been installed we will fill the holes, tarmac the footpath and remove the majority of the barriers down the road.

On Banbury Road we have completed the foul drainage installation towards Bloxham and have started the embankment works, heading North towards Banbury. We are on programme to complete the road works by the New Year where we will have installed a filter lane and two pedestrian islands to help with congestion and pedestrian safety during peak times.

On site we have completed the foundations and have started to install the steel frame. Tarmac has been laid to the car park to enable site to be kept cleaner and reduce the mud out on the road.

Saturday - 08:00 - 13:00 Hours

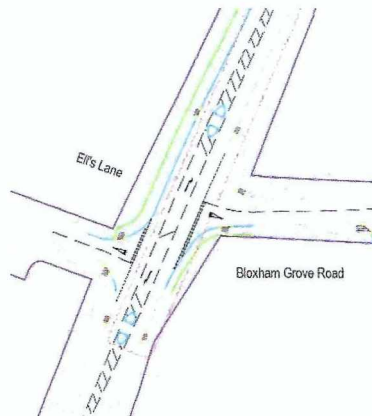
Traffic management monitoring traffic lights 7am - 7pm seven days a week.
